## NOTICE INVITING e-TENDER

Superintending Engineer (Electrical), Arunachal Pradesh Electrical Circle-IV, Dirang, Department of Power, Government of Arunachal Pradesh, invites Sealed Tender for implementation of "Development of Distribution Infrastructure in Tawang District of Arunachal Pradesh under the Revamped Reforms-Based and Results-linked, Distribution Sector Scheme" on Turn-key basis from reputed Firms through online submission of Price Bids/Financial Bids.

The Techno-commercial Bids & Price Bids should be uploaded on website <a href="https://www.arunachaltenders.gov.in">www.arunachaltenders.gov.in</a> and a copy of the Techno-Commercial Bids along with the GTP, EMD and Tender Fees should be submitted in Hard copy for verification at office of the Superintending Engineer (Electrical), Arunachal Pradesh Electrical Circle-IV, Dirang, Department of Power.

Scope of Work: The scope of work includes i) HVDS (construction of 11 kV line in the lengthy LT overhead line Areas), including installation of Distribution transformers and LT lines, ii) Reconfiguration of existing 33/0.415 kV infrastructure to 11/.0415 kV infrastructure, iii) 11 kV infrastructure for down linking with 33/11 kV Sub-Stations under comprehensive Scheme and iv) Cabling works including Re-conductoring works and cabling in natural disaster prone areas, in Tawang District of Arunachal Pradesh under the following Packages on Turn-key basis:

The Intending Tenderers/Firms should satisfy the following conditions. Price Bid/Financial Bids will be opened only for those Tenderers/Firms, who have fulfilled the requirement as per Technical bid.

## 1. CONSTITUTION OF BIDDER/ TENDERER:-

- a) Consortiums/Joint Venture of Firms is not allowed. Hence, all the clauses in SBD related to Joint Venture are to be considered invalid.
- b) Registration Certificate of the bidder should invariably be furnished.
- c) Pre Bid meeting will be held on 28/08/2023 at 1.00 P.M in the Conference Hall of the Superintending Engineer(E), Arunachal Pradesh Electrical Circle- IV, Dirang, Department of Power. The interested bidders are requested to attend the pre-bid meeting without fail.

# 2. QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS (TECHNICAL) :-

- a) Qualification of bidder will be based on meeting the minimum pass/fail criteria specified in the enclosed SBD documents of Infra SBD Part-1, Part-2 & Part-3 as per the Bidder's responses in the corresponding Bid Schedules.
- b) Notwithstanding anything stated herein above, the Employer reserves the right to assess the capacity and capability of the bidder, should the circumstances warrant such assessment in an

overall interest of the Employer. The employer reserves the right to waive minor deviations if they do not materially affect the capability of the Bidder to perform the contract.

#### 2.1. TECHNICAL:

- 2 1.1. For the purpose of this particular bid, bidder shall meet the following minimum criteria in past 7 years (up to last completed financial year):
  - i. Experience in similar work under single contract, costing not less than 70% of the estimated amount of the project. The works under the above contract should be completed works only.

Or

ii. Experience in similar works under two contracts, each costing not less than 40% of the estimated amount of the project. The works under the above two contracts should be completed works only.

Or

- iii. Experience in similar works under three contracts, each costing not less than 30% of the estimated amount of the project. The works under the above three contracts should be completed works only.
- 2.1.2. For the purposes of satisfaction of Technical Requirement, similar works refers to:
  - a) Project(s) execution in one or more sectors below: -
    - 1) Electrical Transmission sector
    - 2) Sub-transmission sector
    - 3) Electrical distribution sector

In above sectors, type of construction works undertaken should be of the nature of one or more of the following:-

- 1) HT lines
- 2) LT lines (Naked Wire/AB Cable)
- 3) Distribution transformers
- 4) Substations
- b) Notwithstanding the clause 2.1.2(a) above, experience in LT lines (AB Cable) would be considered eligible.
- 2.1.3 Work experiences of the bidder as per above shall be considered only if the works have been executed under Govt./semi-Govt./autonomous body of Central/State Govt. /Electricity Power Utility/Power Department in India only. Supporting document in this regard should be necessarily enclosed.

## 2.2. Financial/ Commercial:

- 2.2.1 The Net Worth of the bidder must be positive for the each of the last three Financial Years. Net worth means the sum total of the paid up capital and free reserves (excluding reserves created out of revaluation) reduced by aggregate value of accumulated losses (including debit balance in profit and loss account for current year) and intangible assets.
- 2.2.2. Minimum Average Annual Turnover (MAAT) of the Bidder for best three years out of last five financial years of the bidder should not be less than 30% of the estimated cost of the project rounded off upto two decimal places.
- 2.2 3 Bidder must have liquid assets (LA) and/ or evidence of access to or availability of fund-based credit facilities/ loan against fixed deposit of not less than 10% of the estimated cost of the project rounded off upto two decimal places and the Banker should confirm that the Credit facility is earmarked for the Works specified under Bid on receipt of the Bid. Liquid Assets would include unencumbered cash (and equivalents), bank deposits with maturity less than 365 days, securities that can be freely traded or maturity less than 365 days and receivables which has general certainty of getting received minus payables which has general certainty of getting paid.

The Bidder shall also furnish following documents/details with its bid:

- I. A certificate from banker (as per format) indicating various fund based/non fund based limits sanctioned to the bidder and the extent of utilization as on date Such certificate should have been issued not earlier than three months prior to the date of bid opening. Wherever necessary, the employer may make queries with the Bidders' bankers.
- II. The complete annual reports together with Audited statement of accounts of the company for last five years of its own (separate) immediately preceding the date of submission of bid.

  Note:
  - 1. In the event the bidder is not able to furnish the information of its own (i.e. separate), being a subsidiary company and its accounts are being consolidated with its group/holding/parent company, the bidder should submit the audited balance sheets, income statements, other information pertaining to it only (not of its group/Holding/Parent Company) duly certified by anyone of the authority [(i) Statutory Auditor of the bidder /(ii) Company Secretary of the bidder or (iii) A certified Public Accountant] certifying that such information/documents are based on the audited accounts as the case may be.
  - 2. Similarly, if the bidder happens to be a Group/Holding/Parent Company, the bidder should submit the above documents/information of its own (i.e. exclusive of its subsidiaries) duly certified by anyone of the authority mentioned in Note 2.3.II.1. above certifying that these information/documents are based on the audited accounts, as the case may be.

# III. Litigation History:

- The bidder should provide detailed information on any litigation or arbitration arising out of contracts completed or under execution by it over the last five years a consistent history of awards involving litigation against the Bidder may result in rejection of Bid.
- Notwithstanding anything stated herein above the Employer reserves the right to assess
  the capacity and capability of the bidder, should the circumstances warrant such
  assessment in an overall interest of the Employer. The Employer reserves the right to
  waive minor deviations if they do not materially affect the capability of the Bidder to
  perform the Contract.

#### IV. Site Visit:

It is mandatory for the intending Bidder to submit their respective BIDS after visiting the site and ascertaining for themselves the site conditions, location, surroundings, access to site, handling and storage of materials, applicable laws and regulations, and any other matter considered by them.

Bidders are advised to visit the site and familiarize themselves with the Project within the stipulated time of submission of the Bid.

The Bidders are requested to submit site visit certificate duly issued and signed by the concerned **Executive Engineer (Electrical)** and this will be the integral part of their tender or bid mandatorily.

The Bidder shall visit the site at its own expense and risk.

### 3. Submission of Tenders

- i) The bidder shall upload the Techno-Commercial bid as well as Financial Bid -ONLINE in the website:

  www.arunachaltenders.gov.in and shall submit the Hard copy of Techno-Commercial Bid along with GTP, and original EMD and Tender Fees at Office of the Superintending Engineer (Electrical), Arunachal Pradesh Electrical Circle- IV, Dirang, Department of Power
- ii) The Bidder shall offer only on the price Bid format available in the website www.arunachaltenders.gov.in
- iii) The Bidder have to down load the terms & conditions including Technical Specifications form the enclosed Standard Bids documents available in the website <a href="https://www.arunachaltenders.gov.in">www.arunachaltenders.gov.in</a>
- The Department of Power reserves the right to postpone the date of opening of tender on a situation so arises to warrant its postponement.
- 5. The available Technical Bids will be scrutinized by a Tender Opening Committee and the Price bids will be opened for only the technically qualified bidder who fulfilled the above qualifying (technical) criteria. The decision of the opening Committee will be final and cost of Tender paper will not be refunded.
- 6. The Department of Power will open online Price Bid in the presence of the interested bidders' designated representatives who choose to attend. The interested bidders/Tenderers shall be registered in the website www.arunachaltenders.gov.in
- 7. Offers should invariably be accompanied by:
  - a) The Cost of Tender: Cost of Tender shall be Rs.15,000.00 + GST @18% shall be deposited through NEFT/ RTGS in the account of **EXECUTIVE ENGINEER (E)**, Tawang **Electrical Division**, Tawang, **Department of Power**,

- b) Earnest Money/Bid Security: The Earnest Money/Bid Security shall be 2% of the Estimated Cost for each package shall be deposited in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt/Bank Draft/ Bank Guarantee/Bankers Cheque payable at a branch of Nationalized/ Scheduled Bank duly pledged in favour of the Executive Engineer (Electrical), Tawang Electrical Division, Tawang, Department of Power. Original copies of Earnest Money /Bid Security should be submitted along with the technical bids. Offers without cost of Tender paper & required Earnest Money/ Bid Security will be rejected.
- c) The successful Bidder shall be required to keep its bid security valid for a sufficient period till the performance security (ies) is furnished to the satisfaction of the Employer. The bid security of the successful Bidder will be returned only when the Bidder has signed the Contract Agreement, and has furnished the required performance security.
- 8. If the last date for opening of tenders happens to be a holiday, it will be open on the next working day at the same stipulated time. The Department of Power reserves the right to postpone the date of opening of tender on a situation so arises to warrant its postponement.
- Failure for submission of the completed offer due to poor communications or any other reasons shall be the responsibility of the Company and no time on grounds shall be given.
- 10. The Superintending Engineer (Electrical), APEC- IV, Dirang, Department of power, Government of Arunachal Pradesh reserves the right to accept/reject the lowest or any other offer without assigning any reason whatsoever and the right to split the order, if required.

11. The Legal jurisdiction under this NIT shall be at Tawang District, Arunachal Pradesh.
